## Science congress draws to a close

The curtains came down on the 23 {+r} {+d} Kerala Science Congress (KSC) at the Centre for Earth Science Studies here on Monday evening with the distribution of awards for young scientists and children who presented scientific papers.

C.T.S. Nair, Executive Vice President, Kerala State Council for Science, Technology and Environment (KSCSTE), delivered the valedictory address and gave away the awards.

Addressing the gathering, he stressed the need for more emphasis on basic science research.

## **Basic science**

He said the craze to secure admission for professional courses like medicine and engineering had shifted the focus from basic science. Mr. Nair called upon scientists to focus on socially-relevant research.

Kerala Science Congress chairman R.V.G. Menon said the participation of women scientists was encouraging.

The large number of girls who participated in the children's science congress was also a good sign, he added.
